



## What foals are eligible to participate in the Great Lakes Challenge?

1. Foals are eligible if their sire is nominated to the Great Lakes Challenge for the foaling year.
2. An entry slot is purchased for each foal. An entry slot is valid for an entry in either the Open or Non Pro division or both. Four-year-olds must be named and the entry must be received by April 1 in the year the Derby is held.

### Entry Slot Purchase Opportunity (Make only ONE payment)

On or before September 15 of the foaling year	\$ 250
On or before December 31 of the foaling year	\$ 500
On or before December 31 of the yearling year	\$1,000
On or before December 31 of the 2 year-old year	\$1,500
On or before December 31 of the 3 year-old year	\$2,500

3. An entry slot may be sold or traded until April 1 in the year the Derby is held. The seller of the entry slot must notify Great Lakes Challenge of the sale for the entry slot to remain valid. A \$75.00 transfer fee will be charged to slots that have been transferred. Once a horse is named for the entry slot, it becomes a Great Lakes Challenge entry and can not be sold.
4. Entry slot certificates will be mailed to the buyers. They must be presented at the time of the event. If an entry slot has been transferred, the slot must be presented with the proper signature authorizing the transfer. Entries will not be accepted without certificates.

## How do I nominate my stallion to the Great Lakes Challenge?

1. Stallions are nominated to the Great Lakes Challenge for the year the foals are born. The nomination is based on the advertised breeding fee.

Breeding Fee \$1000 or under	\$300
Breeding Fee \$1001 to \$1500	\$400
Breeding Fee \$1501 and above	\$500

## What classes are offered?

1. The Great Lakes Challenge 2011 will have a 4-Year-Old Open and Non-Pro division. The 4-Year-Old may be entered in either the Open or Non-Pro or both.
2. There will be one go and a finals. The top 25% will advance to the finals. All money will be paid in the finals.

## General Rules

1. Identification of entries must be forwarded to Great Lakes Challenge by April 1 in the year the Derby is held.  
**Registered Horses-** A photocopy of the registration certificate of registered horses.  
**Unregistered Horses-**A notarized statement of age and description by a licensed veterinarian, together with a notarized statement from the owner of the sire that acknowledges parentage.
2. Failure to provide identification as listed above will result in a forfeiture of all fees paid to Great Lakes Challenge and entry is disqualified.
3. Payments will be made to Great Lakes Challenge. All payments must be post-marked on or prior to the due date.
